Our People First meetings happen every first Thursday of the month. In our meetings the members have been coming up with ideas to fundraise. They have also been planning fun events for 2022.


The group has been busy organising a big day trip for everybody this summer. After such a difficult couple of years we are so excited to be able to finally do this.

Bhups has passed his First Aid Training with St John's Ambulance Service. He will now be


able to support the PHAB Group as a fully trained
